
**Share the Plate** is a way to demonstrate our commitment to nonprofit organizations whose actions are consistent with our principles and sources. As of Summer 2025,

congregants had donated over \$40,000 to these causes!

The purpose is two-fold: to inform the congregation of the work of the organization-usually by inviting a representative of the organization to speak briefly, to display literature and



to answer questions during social hour-and to make a financial contribution in the name of the congregation. Since September 2013, 100% of the non-pledge money received for the Share the Plate recipient is given to the chosen agency.
